**Chapter 10**

1. **Aaron** – brother of Moses; the first high priest of the Hebrews
2. **Midian** – land north of Arabia and east of Egypt
3. **Nile River** – longest river in the world, stretching from the Burundi, east Africa, to the Mediterranean Sea in northeast Egypt
4. **Reuel** – Moses’ father-in-law, also called Jethro
5. **Exodus** – God’s liberation of the Hebrew people from slavery in Egypt and his leading them to the Promised Land
6. **matzoh** – flat, thin pieces of unleavened bread eaten by Jewish people during the Passover
7. **Red Sea** – an inlet of the Indian Ocean between Africa and Asia
8. **Seder** – Jewish ceremonial dinner held on the night of Passover in which God is praised as the story of his saving love is told, especially the deliverance of the Chosen People out of Egypt
9. **unleavened** – containing no yeast
10. **consecration** – the part of the Eucharistic Prayer when the Lord’s words of institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper are recited by the priest, making Christ’s Body and Blood present under the appearance of bread and wine
11. **Lectionary** – official book containing the readings for the liturgy for all Sundays and weekdays of the year
12. **Liturgy of the Eucharist** – second part of the Mass, in which Jesus makes present his saving acts, he offers himself to the Father for us,

we join in his sacrifice, he feeds us with the bread and wine that is himself, and we are united and strengthened as God's people

13. **Liturgy of the Word** – first part of the Mass, in which we hear the story of our salvation

14. **votive Masses** – Eucharistic celebrations of the mysteries of the Lord or in honor of Mary and the saints
