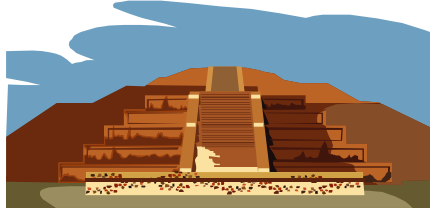

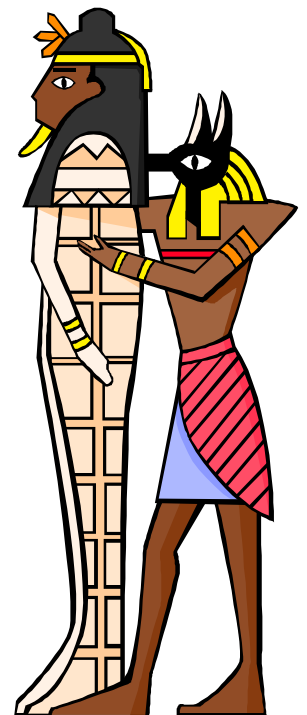
When, Where, and How it happened
